Below is the information required to remotely participate in the BMHA Board of Commissioners Committee Meeting. We will be utilizing **ZOOM MEETING** technology.

This will be an **AUDIO and VIDEO MEETING**. The public will be able to listen in and see presentations (if using an internet connected device) but not participate. We ask you to please keep the audio on MUTE and the video not visible.

Here are the options to connect to the meeting:

- Using any type of phone: (This does not require any additional software/hardware. You will not be able to view any visual meeting content but you will be able to hear all discussion).
 - Dial the number below:

 - When prompted:
 - Enter the **Meeting ID: 898 9649 1850#**
 - If asked for a participant number:
 - Enter: #
 - If asked for a **password**:
 - Enter: **512961**

- If you are connecting via a computer or any other internet device (smart phone, IPAD, tablet, etc.): **you must have an internet connection, speakers on your computer for audio and the ZOOM software installed.**

 - Your device will open your internet browser.
 - If you do not have the ZOOM application on your device, you will be asked to either download the software or get/install the APP. This is a very easy process, but may take a few minutes based on the device you are using and your internet speed.
 - Once downloaded, open the downloaded file and run/install it on your device.
 - You will be prompted to join the meeting.
 - Enter the appropriate meeting information as directed:
 - **Meeting ID: 898 9649 1850**
 - **Password: 512961**
 - Once part of the meeting, you will be asked to join the audio of the meeting. Select **JOIN INTERNET AUDIO**. If you do not have a microphone or speakers on your device (phones, IPADS, notebooks, have them; your computer may not), you must dial in on a phone in order to hear the audio meeting.
